Ways to Volunteer

1. **Tutor** (30 minutes – 1 hour per week during the school day) Help students learn and achieve in school! Provide content tutoring in academic subjects, help with homework, and support study skills development.
2. **Mentor** (30 minutes – 1 hour per week during the school day) Help students grow and develop! Provide encouragement, support, and a positive role model for young people, and help them stay on track.
3. **Classroom assistant**--volunteer to work in a classroom once or twice a week for about 45 minutes assisting a small group of students or the teacher as requested.
4. **Reality Store Volunteer** – (several hours during the school day once a semester or year). The Reality Store is an interactive educational event designed for students to learn about how their education, life choices and finances are all interrelated and impact their future. Volunteers man stations to guide students as they buy a house, provide childcare, pay utilities, etc.
5. **After-school Clubs assistant** – (1-2 hours a week for 6 weeks). Volunteers are needed to help assist with “after school clubs” such as Cooking Matters, Girls Club, etc.
